March Prayer Pointers

During Lent we set aside time to take stock of our lives and to reconsider how we are living in the light of God's presence and power made available to us in Jesus. This is what Lent is for, to reflect on our lives as they are, and as they could be. May the following pointers help you on your journey to the Cross this Easter.

- **Praise God for who He is and thank Him for what He has done for you.**
"For God so loved the world that He gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life". John 3 v 16
- **Remember God's love and grace for you.**
"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast" Ephesians 2 vs 8-9
- **Confess to God those times when you have been selfish, judgmental, bitter, proud, unforgiving, hypocritical....**
"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness". 1 John 1 v 9
- **Ask God to reveal those areas in your life that need to change by His transforming power.**
"Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting" Ps 139 vs 23-24
- **Give thanks that God loves you no matter what your life's experience has been, is or will be.**
"The Lord your God is with you, He is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing". Zephaniah 3 v 17
