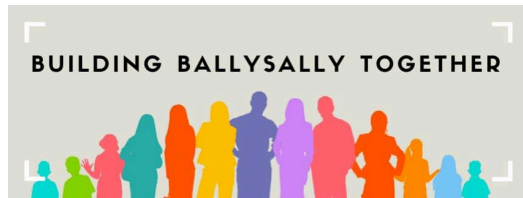

### **Ballysally foodbank donations**

We continue to donate towards the Ballysally Building Together project. Items of greatest value to the team at present include tinned meat and fish, tinned fruit and vegetables, soup, creamed rice and packets of pasta or noodles which only require the addition of hot water. *Their cereal supply has reduced greatly so they would appreciate boxes of cereal again!*

Monetary donations towards the female hygiene project or foodbank are also welcomed.

At present, around 70 families are availing themselves of your donations, helping them survive difficult financial times.
