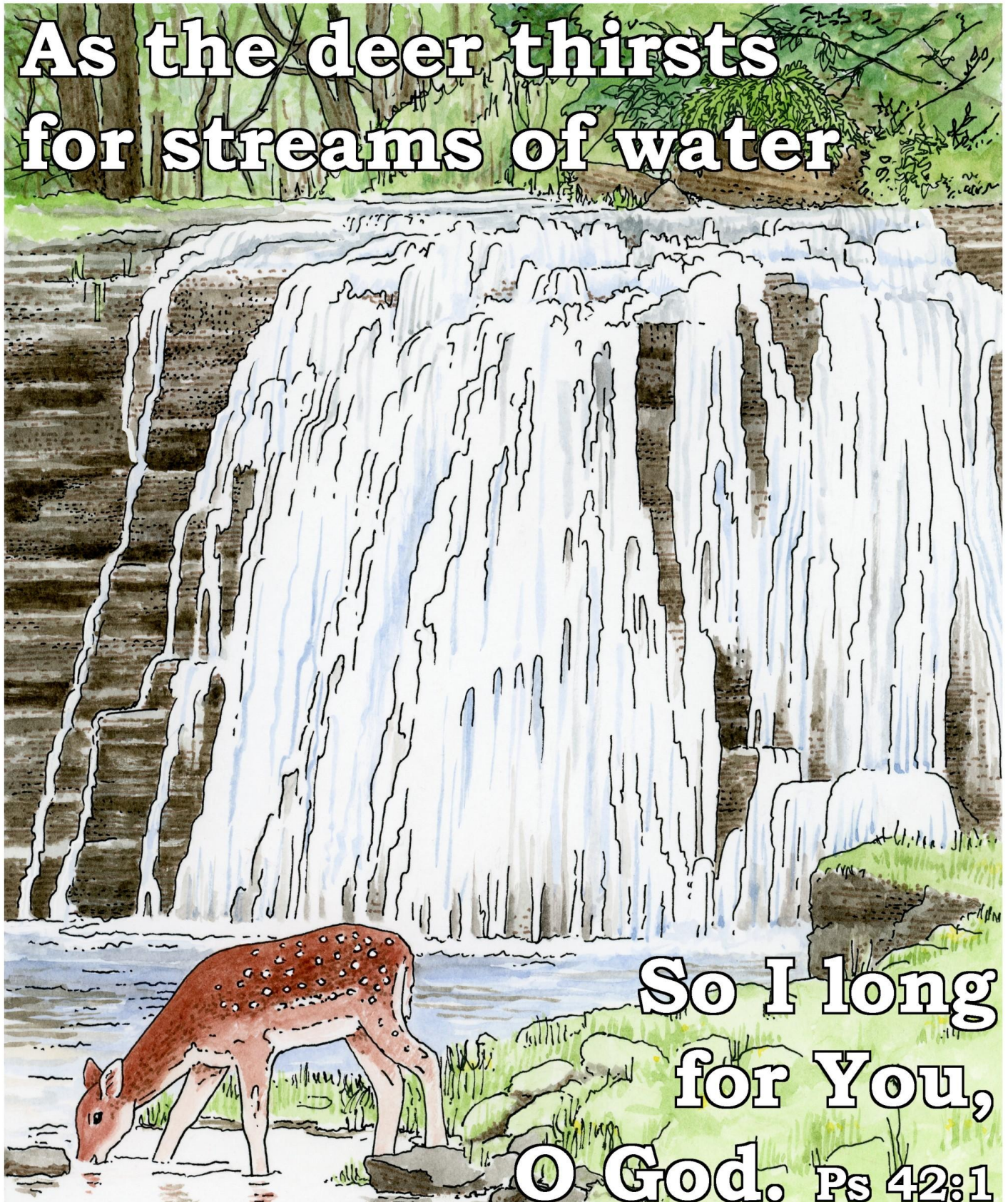

Prayer Corner

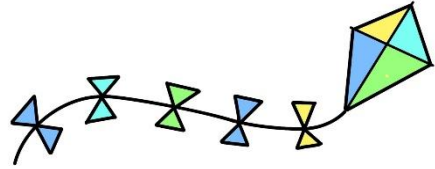

For our World:

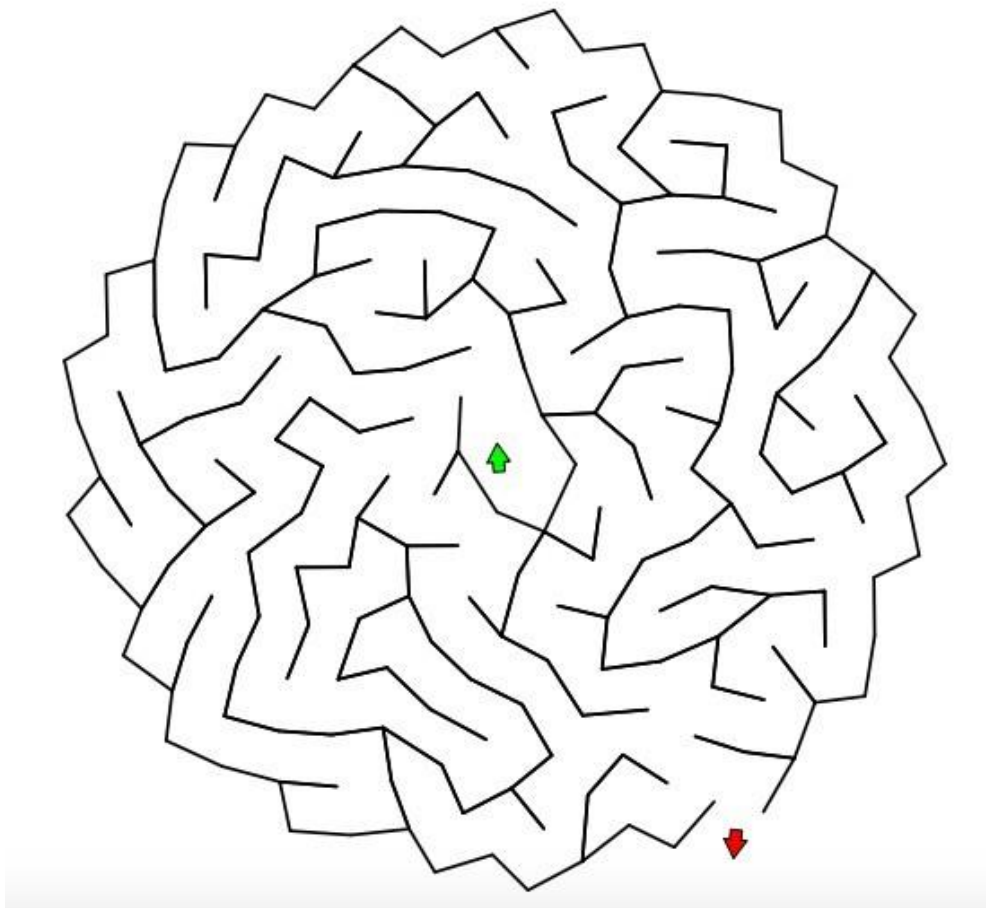

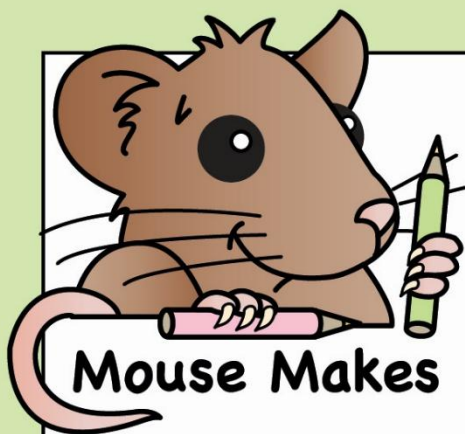
We will publish full amount received next week. All that remains for us now is to think what challenge we will tackle for 2026!

Smiles all round it's only 8.30 and these men have 2 peaks done!!! 🍌🍌🍌

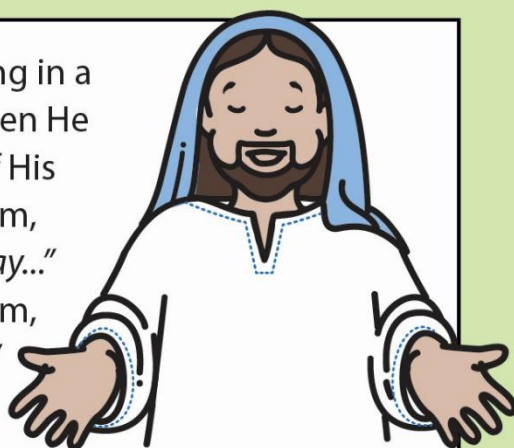

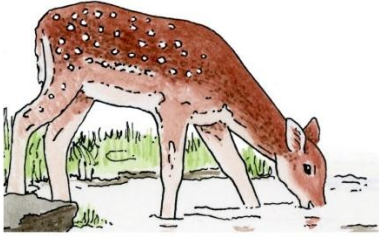
